

Aim & Scope

The peer review process usually complete near about 1 month time, depending upon the number of research paper in queue.

Submission

Is it possible to submit the same article to JCT and another Journal simultaneously?

No! Not at all. You have to give an undertaking that the article submitted by you is not published or submitted for publication in any other journal. The article not accepted by JCT can be published in any other journal. The intimation for non-acceptance of article will reach you within 90 days of the submission of article to JCT through email.

How and where should I send my manuscript?

Reviewing

How does the review process work?

The review of articles is done through a blind peer review. All the articles received by JCT, are send to Review Committee after deleting the name of the author to have an unbiased opinion about the research. JCT, also, conducts a electronic review through anti-plagiarism software and google search.

How do you choose the reviewers?

Eminent academicians are on the editorial and review board of JCT along with that we have a panel of renowned academicians and industry professionals to review the research articles.

How long do reviews usually take?

Minimum time for review of any article is one month. But, sometimes foreign reviewers take more time nearing 2 months.

Publication

How long does it take for an accepted paper to be actually published?

The theme for every month is displayed two months prior to the publishing of the issue. It takes minimum one month for an accepted article to be published. If the accepted article does not come under the theme of that quarter, the time taken to publish the article would be longer. The period of publication is fixed i.e., April and October every year.
